

AMPM Counterfeit Products Avoidance Policy

Aircraft Missile Parts Manufacturing (AMPM) is a division of Alvord-Polk Inc. AMPM and the other corporate divisions of Alvord-Polk Inc. are certified to a comprehensive quality management system Standard ISO9001:2008 accredited by NSF International Strategic Registrations # 84311-IS2.

AMPM understands the growing concern over the increased volume of fraudulent/counterfeit materials and parts entering the aerospace supply chain. If undetected, the suspect components could lead to reduced part performance and reliability. AMPM has always viewed non-traceable materials, or surplus parts as inherently suspect and reviewed accordingly.

AMPM therefore pledges the following:

- 1. Materials will be procured directly from original manufacturers or their authorized distributors and will be accompanied by the appropriate certifications.
- 2. No less than once a year, procured material samples will be sent out to an independent testing agency to verify the composition and certifications.
- 3. Factory new parts will be procured directly from original manufacturers or their authorized dealers.
- 4. AMPM maintains a register of approved suppliers, including the scope and criteria for their approval. AMPM does not procure product from suppliers outside the United States.
- 5. Visual Inspection, measurement, manufacturer markings, verification of date codes and lot numbers, and non-destructive evaluation will be used based upon risk assessment.
- 6. Discovery of counterfeit parts will be immediately reported to GIDEP and all pertinent governing bodies.
